We are writing to let you know that **Tree Hugger Travel** has made a donation to World Land Trust's Buy an Acre programme on your behalf to help purchase, protect and manage Quarter of an Acre of threatened habitat.

As agreed, this donation has been earmarked for WLT's Buy an Acre programme which is currently supporting WLT partner Fundacion Biodiversidad Argentina (FBA) to create the Chaco Tagua Biological Corridor to protect Dry Chaco habitat within Cordoba Province where less than 5% of native forests remain. This corridor will connect two protected areas, extending the habitat for species of the area including globally endangered Chaco Peccary, 229 species of birds, 35 mammal species and 43 species of amphibians and reptiles.

We are delighted that our corporate supporter, Tree Hugger Travel, has chosen to demonstrate their commitment to environmental issues through WLT's Buy an Acre programme and we have pleasure in enclosing a certificate in recognition of this support.
